Toronto, February 9, 2010 – After working with eight corporate CEOs, two United States Senators and as a member of the Reagan Administration, communications guru Robert Waite is finally striking out on his own.

Waite, who has headed up communications and stakeholder relations functions at firms as diverse as IBM, Ford, CIBC, CAE and, most recently, at Canada Post Corporation, today announced the formation of Waite + Co. With offices in Toronto and Ottawa, Waite + Co. will offer strategic stakeholder advice and counsel to C-Suite executives and senior government leaders.

In Canada, government relations were among Waite's responsibilities at CAE Inc., CIBC and Canada Post.

Born in Boston, Massachusetts and educated at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, Waite came to Canada in 1986 on a two-year developmental assignment with Ford Motor Company. He was lured away from Ford in 1988 by IBM Canada to provide executive communications support to their newly-installed CEO, John M. Thompson. Waite became a Canadian citizen in 1995.

"I have known Bob Waite for more than 15 years and he has a great reputation within the communications profession", said Dick O'Hagan, a former press secretary to Prime Ministers Lester Pearson and Pierre Elliott Trudeau, who himself has achieved notable success as a trusted advisor to corporate executives. "There are those who call him Canada's CEO Whisperer—and I think that really reflects his thoughtful manner and his ability to remain calm and focused on big-picture strategic and reputation issues, even in the midst of turmoil."
